Partnering with CityLife to learn about apartment ministry, serve in many capacities, and learning how to read and lead through the Bible.

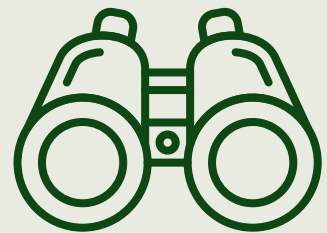

Leading Bible programs for kids, helping out with local coffee farms and ministries, rural church encouragement and meeting needs.



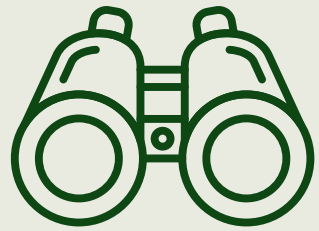

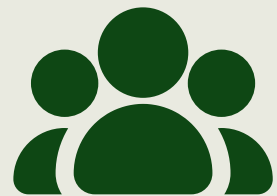
## FOCUS

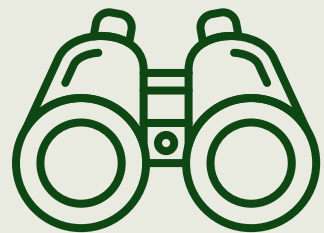

# DOMINICAN REPUBLIC





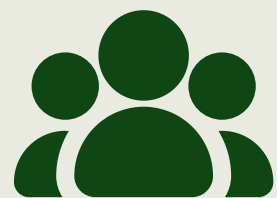
## FOCUS

Plant seeds of God's love among unbelievers through home and prayer visits, teach Bible lessons to kids in the community, and participate in outreach strategies to help the church meet new people.



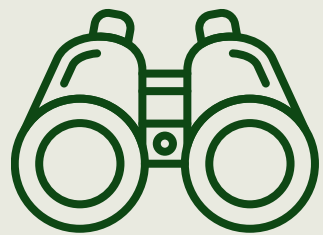

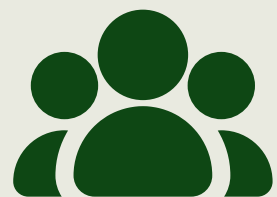
## FOCUS

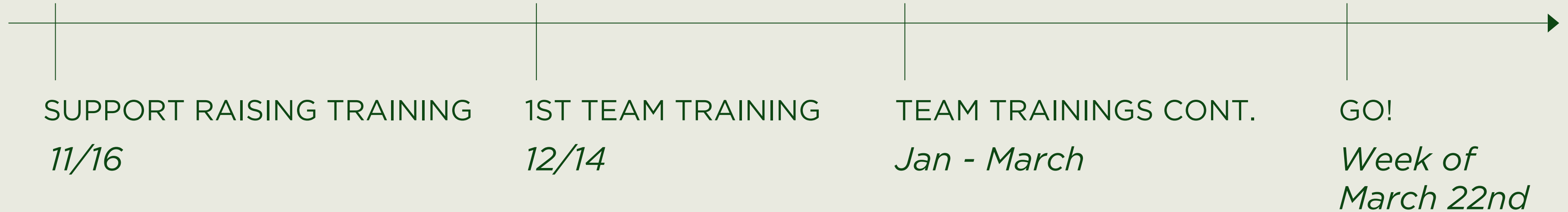
