PALM SUNDAY | The Last Week

Luke 19:29-40

Let's start with Highs/Lows from Covid. What has been your favorite moment of this season (high) and what has been your lowest moment?

The last week of Christ's life had highs and lows. Let's read through the stories and reflect on them as a group.

Read Luke 19:28-40. What was the reaction of the crowds as Jesus approached Jerusalem? How do you think this "high" moment properly captured the true nature of Jesus?

Read Luke 22:7-20. What was special about this last night with the disciples? When Jesus shared the bread and the cup, what were the elements foreshadowing?

**Read Luke 22:39-53.** A garden is usually a place of peace and life. How does the Garden of Gethsemane become a place of conflict and darkness for Jesus? What else stands out to you from these verses?

Read Matthew 27:11-31. Jesus was unjustly convicted, punished, and executed. How do the Scriptures that describe the mistreatment of Jesus make you feel?

Take Communion together as a group. Read Isaiah 53:3-6 to bring it all together.
