


The Scarlet Cord

The Scarlet Thread of Scripture

Ephesians 2:12-13 ESV

Remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Revelation 5:6a, 9-10 NIV

Then I saw **a Lamb**, looking as if it had been slain, standing at the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders.
