
These are the inheritances that the people of Israel received in the land of Canaan, which Eleazar the priest and Joshua the son of Nun and the heads of the fathers' houses of the tribes of the people of Israel gave them to inherit. 2 Their inheritance was by lot, just as the LORD had commanded by the hand of Moses for the nine and one-half tribes. 3 For Moses had given an inheritance to the two and one-half tribes beyond the Jordan, but to the Levites he gave no inheritance among them.

For the people of Joseph were two tribes, Manasseh and Ephraim. And no portion was given to the Levites in the land, but only cities to dwell in, with their pasturelands for their livestock and their substance. ⁵ The people of Israel did as the LORD commanded Moses; they allotted the land.

Caleb

To the tribe of Levi alone Moses gave no inheritance. The offerings by fire to the LORD God of Israel are their inheritance, as he said to him. **Joshua 13:14** ESV

But to the tribe of Levi Moses gave no inheritance; the LORD God of Israel is their inheritance, just as he said to them. **Joshua 13:33** ESV

And no portion was given to the Levites in the land, but only cities to dwell in, with their pasturelands for their livestock and their substance. **Joshua 14:4b** ESV

But the Jebusites, the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the people of Judah could not drive out, **Joshua 15:63a** ESV

Yet the people of Manasseh could not take possession of those cities, but the Canaanites persisted in dwelling in that land. **Joshua 17:12** ESV

So Joshua said to the people of Israel, "How long will you put off going in to take possession of the land, which the LORD, the God of your fathers, has given you?"

And all the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron. **Numbers 14:2a** ESV

"Let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt."

Numbers 14:4b ESV

And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will this people despise me? And how long will they not believe in me, in spite of all the signs that I have done among them?" **Numbers 14:11** ESV

And now, behold, the LORD has kept me alive, just as he said, these forty-five years since the time that the LORD spoke this word to Moses, while Israel walked in the wilderness. And now, behold, I am this day eighty-five years old."

"I am still as strong today as I was in the day that Moses sent me; my strength now is as my strength was then, for war and for going and coming. ¹² So now give me this hill country of which **the LORD spoke on that day**, for you heard on that day how the Anakim were there, with great fortified cities. It may be that the LORD will be with me, and I shall drive them out **just as the LORD said**."

"The land, which we passed through to spy it out, is an exceedingly good land. ⁸ If the LORD delights in us, he will bring us into this land and give it to us, a land that flows with milk and honey. ⁹ Only do not rebel against the LORD. And do not fear the people of the land, for they are bread for us. Their protection is removed from them, and the LORD is with us; do not fear them."
