Heavenly Father, You are proclaimed the true font of light and wisdom, and the Creator raised high above all things.


Pour forth a ray of Your brightness into the darkened places of our minds; disperse from our souls the twofold darkness into which we were born: sin and ignorance.


Grant to us keenness of mind, capacity to remember, skill in learning, subtlety to interpret, and eloquence in speech.



















# The Gospel of the Kingdom


# The Gospel of the Kingdom



- <sup>6</sup> Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied."


# Living in the In-Between
